Did you know Red Pandas have a superpower? They can turn invisible! A Red Panda's colors camouflage them from predators. Learn more below, and color as you go!

WHITE on their face is almost "luminescent" and can guide a mother's lost cubs in the darkness

RED on their backs is the same color as moss found on the trees where they live

A long tail helps balance across tree branches

Claws are retractable like a cat's claws



BLACK on Red Panda's stomachs make them difficult to spot when you look up into trees

Furry paws help help grip onto slippery, mossy branches

The fluffy tail also acts as a blanket in winter to keep the Red Panda warm

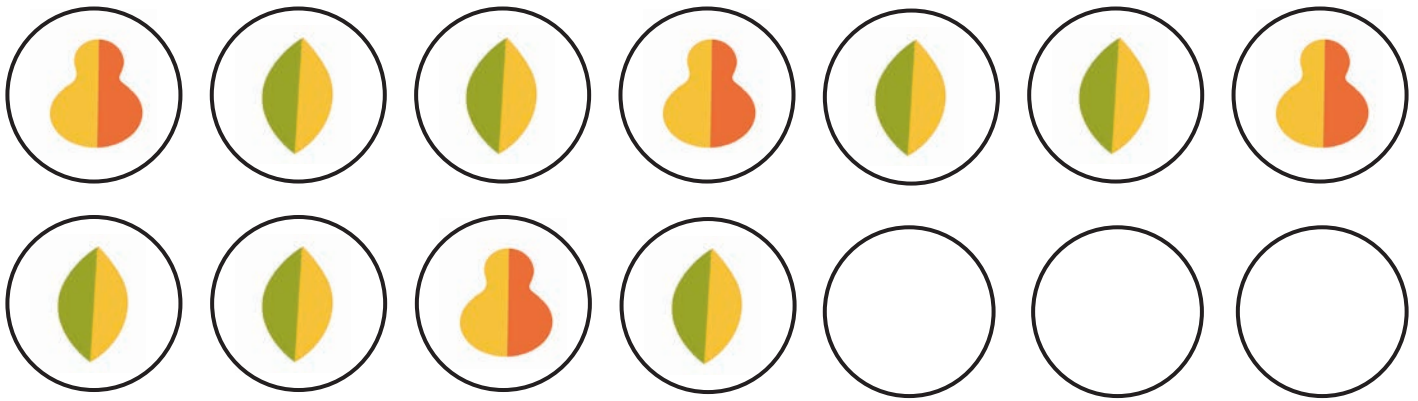
